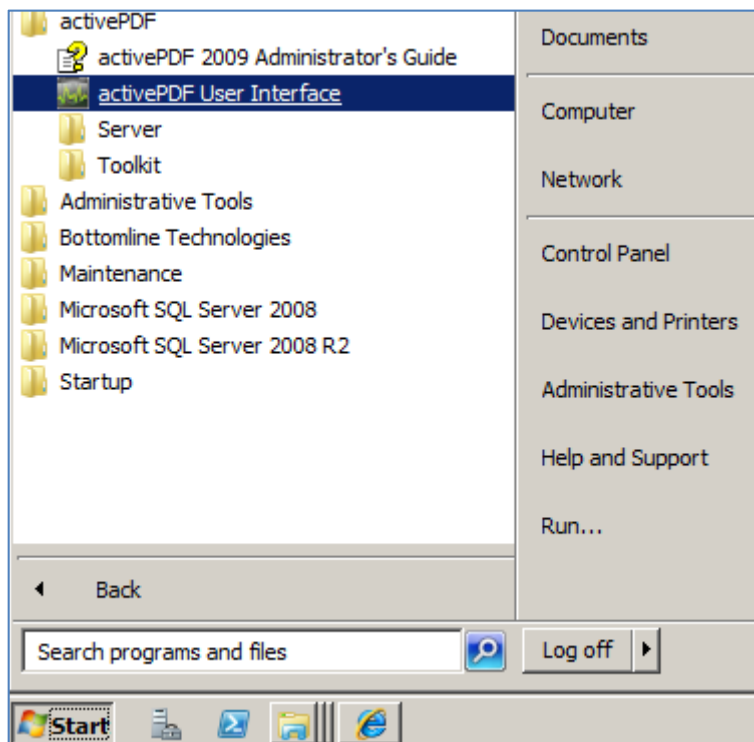
### How to set compression settings in activePDF

When Transform is installed the activePDF compression settings are not applied. This means that most PDF's produced are quite large in size

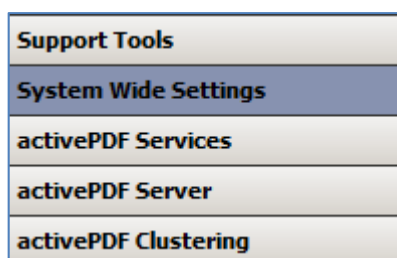
If you are experiencing large file sizes for your PDFs then you will require to set the compression settings

There is a setting in the **activePDF Common User Interface** that will reduce the size of a PDF

Open the **activePDF User Interface** program



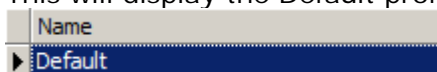
Once loaded – click on **System Wide settings**



Double-Click on the **PDF profiles icon**

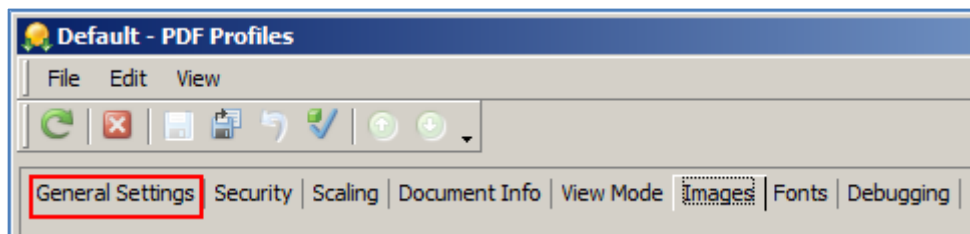


This will display the Default profile

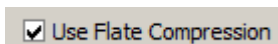


Double Click the **Default** profile name

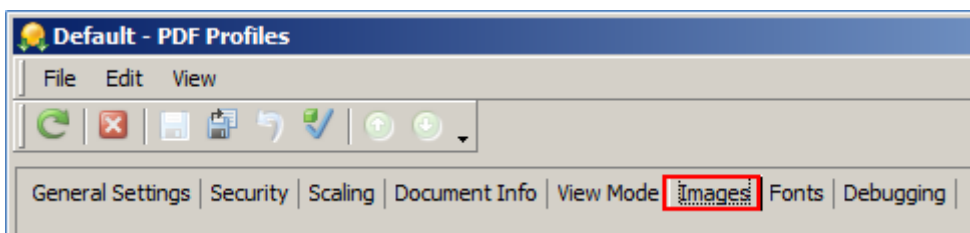
When the Default – PDF profiles dialog appears – click on the **General** tab



Ensure that “**Use Flate Compression**” has been ticked



Then click on the **Images** tab



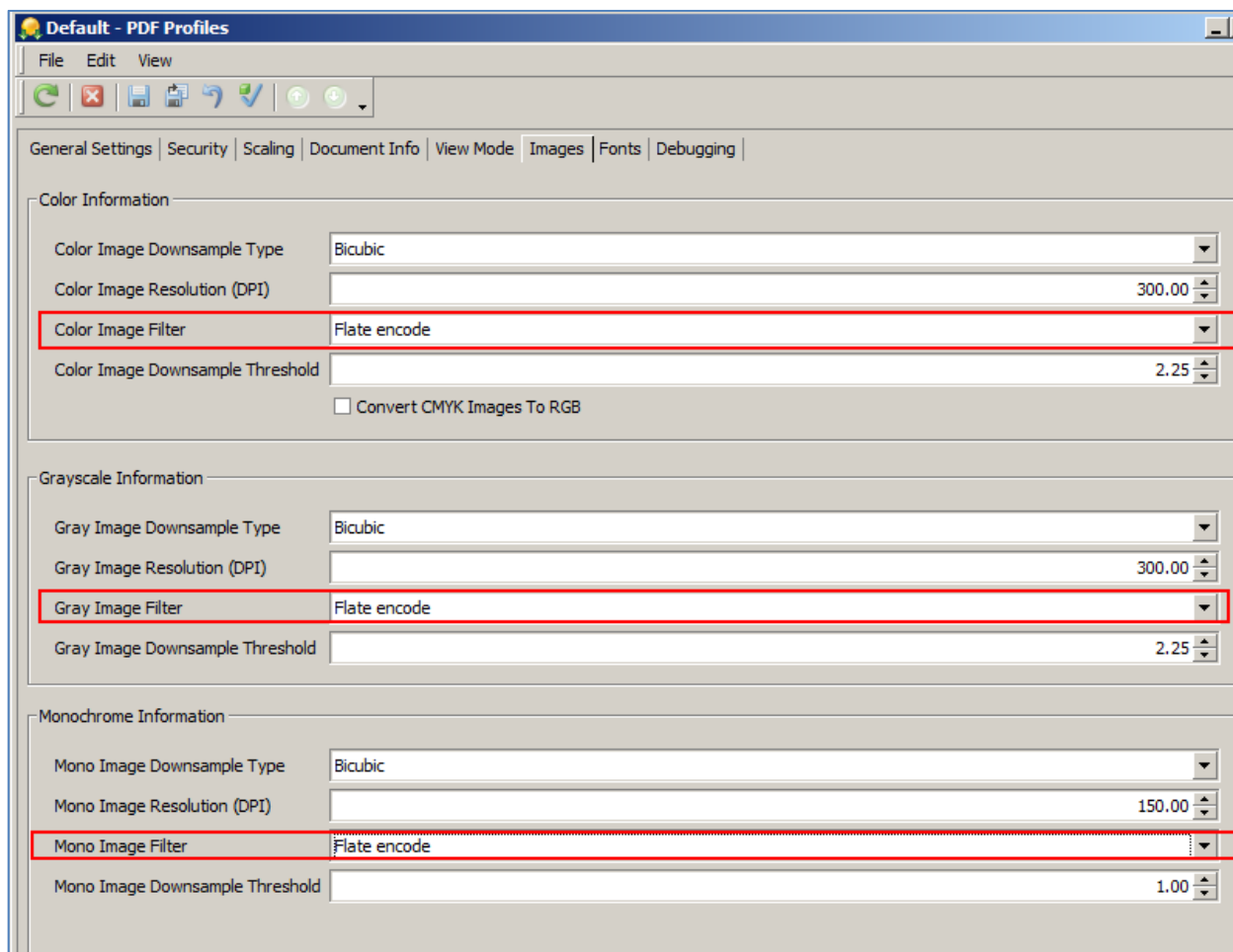
There are three settings that need to be modified

Using the dropdown button – set the following **from “None” to “Flate Encode”**

**Color Image Filter**

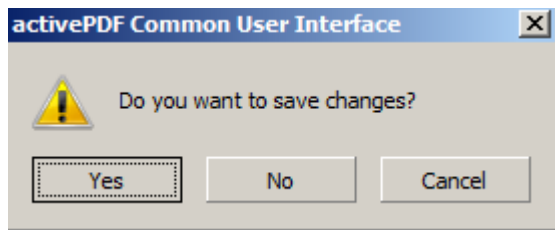
**Grey Image Filter**

**Mono Image Filter**



Close the dialog screen and it will prompt you to save your changes

Click **Yes**



And then close the activePDF Common User Interface
